

We are really, excited to announce our headliners: Polar, who will be fresh off the back of their Five Arrows European Tour.

Polar are a five piece "emotive, melodic hardcore band" Kerrang, originally hailing from Guildford after forming in 2009 and dropped their 6th studio album in late 2024 and their most recent two singles have been garnering support from BBC Radio 1 Introducing with regular airplay on the rock show.

"Five Arrows is the beginning of a brand new era of Polar and the record is a symbol of resilience. The album allows the band to break the mold musically to what has come before, pushing the sound sonically in a brand-new direction but at the same time not losing the rawness and energy that the band has come to be known for. To accompany the newfound sound, lyrically it digs deep into the theme of the destructive power of change and the positive and negatives that come with it."

The Proteans are an adult community theatre workshop company run by Proteus, whose ethos is to explore creativity, performance and above all to come together for the sheer enjoyment of making, performing and experiencing live theatre.

The Proteans have a long history of performing popular plays each summer at Basingstoke's Walled Garden, the most recent being The Tempest in 2023 and just recently Noel Coward's Hay Fever.

The group can also choose to participate in other plays or projects throughout the year and have recently finished a successful and self-directed 3-night run of Dickensian spoof Round the Twist and prior to that a 4 night sell-out run of Terry Pratchett's Mort. The Proteans also frequently get involved in larger participatory projects that Proteus undertake from festivals to multi-generational immersive theatre shows.

Members are invited to see all of Proteus' professional performances and critically engage in the work, being a member also affords access to see work in development from some of the industry's most exciting artists and to work alongside professional theatre practitioners in specialist workshops.

A friendly and sociable group, they only undertake performances when they feel like it, and even then, not all the members of the group have to be involved. Whilst many of the current members are very active participants - anyone who has previously participated is always welcome to pick back up with the group when the time is right.

## ROSENCRANTZ AND GUILDENSTERN ARE DEAD

Rosencrantz and Guildenstern are Dead is a play by Tom Stoppard which, as it were, takes place in the wings of Hamlet, and finds both humour and poignancy in the situation of the ill-fated attendant lords.



Influenced by Waiting for Godot and influencing Withnail and I and Groundhog Day, the plays' wit, stagecraft and verbal verve remain as exhilarating as they were when it was first produced, and the play has become a contemporary classic with actors from Gary Oldman to Daniel Radcliffe taking on the central roles.

The Proteans take on Stoppard's legendary comedy and bring a fresh perspective on this groundbreaking work. Funny, surreal, thoughtful and highly physical, this is a real theatrical treat.

You're SO F\*\*king Croydon!' is a bold, unapologetic dive into the female working-class experience and noughties club culture, seamlessly blending music, dance, comedy, spoken word, and Croydon's most infamous celebrities.

"It was my nemesis, I hated Croydon with a real vengeance. It represented everything I didn't want in my life, everything I wanted to get away from. I think it's the most derogatory thing I can say about somebody or something: 'God, it's so f\*\*king Croydon!'" – David Bowie

Set against the gritty backdrop of Croydon's reputation, this dynamic and interactive show aims to challenge Bowies quote. It's not just a

story about a place, but about every woman who's been defined by where she comes from. With a cheeky "Love of Huns" aesthetic and a euphoric 'Save the Last Dance'-esque finale, the show celebrates resilience, power, and the refusal to be pigeonholed.

Whether you've walked Croydon's streets or not, this show resonates with humour, heart, and a strut down memory lane, featuring David Bowie in the most unexpected ways.

Basingstoke audiences will well appreciate the irony of stereotypes attached to certain locations, but this very funny and joyful show strives to dispel the notion that being from a particular place diminishes someone's worth.
